





# IEEE International Symposium on Power Line Communications and its Applications

The 18th IEEE International Symposium on Power Line Communications and its Applications will be held in Glasgow, Scotland, from March 30 to April 2, 2014. ISPLC is the flagship conference of the IEEE Communications Society Technical Committee on Power Line Communications, and has been financially and technically sponsored by the IEEE Communications Society since 2006.

Glasgow is the largest city in Scotland, and offers a rich cultural and industrial heritage. A welcoming city with a population of around 800.000, it has won numerous awards for its architecture, culture, and hospitality. In 2014, Glasgow will be the proud host of not only ISPLC 2014 but also the Commonwealth Games, which will bring considerable excitement to the city. ISPLC 2014 will bring together academia and industry professionals to present and discuss state of the art solutions and research results on existing and future power line communication (PLC) systems, PLC applications, and PLC standardization activities. The contributions presented at ISPLC will span all aspects of communications over power lines, including access, home networking, in-vehicle applications, utility applications, smart grids, green communications and more. Topics from related fields such as wireless that highlight analogies or differences with PLC and stimulate cross-fertilization will be discussed.

ISPLC has been a successful conference for 18 years, and it is recognized as the major international conference in the PLC field. ISPLC 2014 will have the participation of utilities (telecom, electric, water, and gas), regulatory agencies (energy and telecom), governmental institutions, R&D institutes, universities, manufactures, technology and solution providers, integrators.
